

## What is Prayer?

Prayer is the second pillar of Islam and it is the most repeated. Every Muslim must pray 5 times everyday. Fajr prayer is 2 rak'ahs, Dhuhr prayer is 4 rak'ahs, Asr prayer is 4 rak'ahs, Maghrib prayer is 3 rak'ahs, and Ishaa prayer is 4 rak'ahs,

#### Why is prayer important?

#### 1- Prayer removes sins

Prophet Muhammad said: "If there was a river by the door of any one of you, and he bathed in it five times each day, would there be any trace of dirt left on him?" They said: "No trace of dirt would be left on him." He said: "That is the likeness of the five daily prayers. By means of them Allah erases sins." [Bukhari and Muslim]

#### 2- Prayer helps you quit the sins

When you pray, Allah will help you to do what is right and keep you away from what is wrong.

إِنَّ الصَّلَاةَ تَنْهَىٰ عَنِ الْفَحْشَاءِ وَالْمُنكَرِ [ المنكبوت: 45]

Indeed, prayer prevents from Al-Fahshaa (immoral sins) and Al-Munkar (evil deeds)

# 3- Prayer is the first thing we will be asked about on the Day of Judgment.

The Messenger of Allah () said, "The first of man's deeds for which he will be called to account on the Day of Resurrection will be prayer. If it is found to be perfect, he will be safe and successful; but if it is incomplete, he will be unfortunate and a loser.

#### How to pray?

Every prayer is composed of a number of rak'ahs (units). Each unit is composed of a set of sayings and movements.

- 1- Neyyah
- 2- Standing.
- 3- Takbeeratu Al-Ihram
- 4- Reciting Surah Al-Fatihah.
- 5- Reading another Surah after Al-Fatihah.
- 6- Ruku' (bowing down) and say (Subhana rabiyyah al-'atheem)
- 7- Standing up from Ruku' and say Sami'a Allah liman hamidah.
- 8- Sujood (prostrating) and say (Subhana rabiyyah al-a'ala).
- 9- Sitting up after sujood and say (rabbi ighfir li)
- 10- Go down for sujood again and say (Subhana rabiyyah ala'ala).
- 11- Raising from sujood.

this is called one rak'ah, if you are doing fajr prayer, you will need to this two times, in Asr prayer, you will need to do this 4 times.



## Tashahhud

12- If the prayer is more than two Rakah's, you need to do something after raising from the second sujood, which is the middle Tashahhud.

ٱلتَّحِيَّاتُ لِلَّهِ وَٱلصَّلَوَاتُ وَٱلطَّيِّبَاتُ، ٱلسَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ أَيُّهَا ٱلنَّبِيُّ وَرَحْمَةُ ٱللَّهِ وَبَرَكَاتُهُ، ٱلسَّلَامُ عَلَيْنَا وَعَلَىٰ عِبَادِ ٱللَّهِ ٱلصَّالِحِينَ، أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَٰهَ إِلَّا ٱللَّهُ، وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ.

at-taḥiyyātu li-llāhi, wa-ṣ-ṣalawātu wa-ṭ-ṭayyibātu. as-salāmu ʿalayka ʾayyuhā n-nabiyyu wa raḥmatu -llāhi wa barakātuhu. as-salāmu ʿalaynā wa ʿalā ʿibādi -llāhi ṣ-ṣāliḥīna. ʾashhadu ʾan lā ʾilāha ʾillā -llāhu wa ʾashhadu ʾanna muḥammadan ʿabduhu wa rasūluhū.

"Salutations to Allah and prayers and good deeds. Peace be upon you, O Prophet, as well as Allah's mercy and His blessings. Peace be upon us and upon the righteous servants of Allah. I bear witness that there is no deity but Allah, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and His Messenger."

#### Prayer

13- At the end of Prayer, you have to recite the last tashahhud:

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَىٰ آلِ مُحَمَّدٍ كَمَا صَلَّيْتَ عَلَىٰ إِبْرَاهِيمَ وَعَلَىٰ آلِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ إِنَّكَ حَمِيدٌ مَجِيدٌ اللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ عَلَىٰ مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَىٰ آلِ مُحَمَّدٍ كَمَا بَارَكْتَ عَلَىٰ إِبْرَاهِيمَ وَعَلَىٰ آلِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ إِنَّكَ حَمِيدٌ مَجِيدٌ

Allāhumma ṣalli 'alā Muḥammadin wa 'alā āli Muḥammad(in), kamā ṣallayta 'alā Ibrāhīma wa 'alā āli Ibrāhīm(a), innaka Ḥamīdun Majīd. Allāhumma bārik 'alā Muḥammadin wa 'alā āli Muḥammad(in), kamā bārakta 'alā Ibrāhīma wa 'alā āli Ibrāhīm(a), innaka Ḥamīdun Majīd.

O Allah, send prayers upon Muhammad and upon the family of Muhammad just as You have sent prayers upon Ibrahim and upon the family of Ibrahim, verily You are the Praiseworthy, the Glorious. O Allah, bless Muhammad and the family of Muhammad just as You have blessed Ibrahim and the family of Ibrahim, verily You are the Praiseworthy, the Glorious.

#### 14- Tasleeem at the end:

Tasleem is the last action in the prayer by saying "Assalamualaikum warahmatullah" one time to the right side and another to the lest side.


