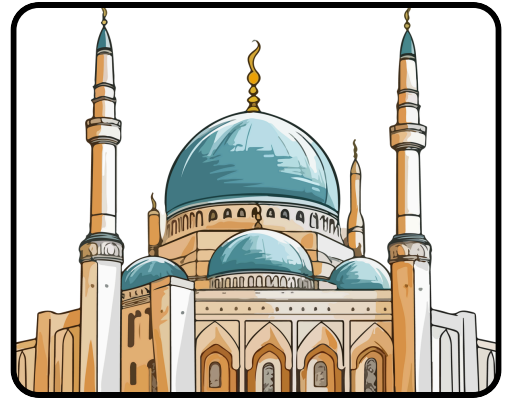

## What Do We Do When We Hear the Adhan?

When you hear the Adhan, here's what you can do:

1. Stop and Listen: Stop what you're doing and listen carefully.
2. Repeat the Words: You should repeat the words of the Adhan.
3. Make Dua: After the Adhan finishes, you can make a special dua, asking Allah to bless the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) and to give you a chance to join him in Jannah (Paradise).

## Who Calls the Adhan?

The person who calls the Adhan is called a Mu'adhin (Mu-ad-dhin). The Mu'adhin has a very important job because they help everyone get ready for prayer.

## When is the Adhan Called?

The Adhan is called five times a day for each of the five daily prayers: Fajr, Dhuhr, Asr, Maghrib, and Isha. So no matter where you are, you can hear the Adhan or check the prayer Apps to know the time for prayer.
