
#### **HADITH**

Abu Musa Al-Ash'ari (May Allah be pleased with him) said: I asked the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ): "Who is the best among the Muslims?" He said, "One from whose tongue and hands Muslims are secure."

[Al-Bukhari and Muslim]

#### The Meaning of the Hadith

One of the Sahabah asked the Prophet , what kind of people are the best? the Sahabi asked because he wanted to be one of them. The Prophet said the best of Muslims is the one who does not harm or hurt others with his hands or with his tongue.

Hurting others with your hand will be like hitting or pushing someone or taking something that does not belong to you. Hurting others with your tongue means cursing, lying, backbiting. Be careful of what you do and what you say if you want to be a good Muslim.

Sometimes we make mistakes, but it is very important to apologize when a mistake happens and ask for forgiveness from Allah and from the person we were mean too.

Always remind yourself, your siblings and your friends to be kind and peaceful and not to hurt anyone in anyway.
