

Keeping Clean in Islam: Why It's Important

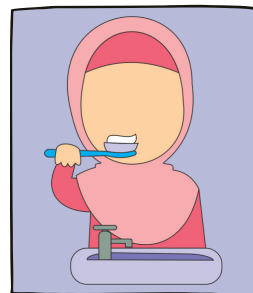
In Islam, cleanliness and good manners are very important! One of the best things we can do as Muslims is to stay clean, both inside and out. Cleanliness is part of something called Taharah (Ta-ha-rah), which means keeping ourselves pure and tidy. Allah loves it when we are clean, smell good, and look nice. It's something that makes our hearts and our homes feel peaceful!

Imagine this: every time you wash your hands, brush your teeth, or tidy your room, you're doing something that makes Allah happy and pleases our Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him)! Even something simple, like making your bed when you wake up, is a good deed. If you leave your bed messy, it's like inviting Shaytan (the one who loves messiness) to come and stay around. Keeping things neat and clean keeps Shaytan away and invites Allah's blessings.

Allah Loves Cleanliness

Allah tells us in the Quran that He loves people who turn back to Him, asking for forgiveness, and who keep themselves pure: **إِنَّ اللَّهَ يُحِبُّ التَّوَّابِينَ وَيُحِبُّ الْمُتَطَهِّرِينَ**
"Allah loves those who turn to Him and He loves those who keep themselves pure and clean." [Quran 2:222]

So, every time you do something to stay clean, like washing for prayer, tidying your room, or brushing your teeth, you're doing something special. Allah sees it, and He loves it!

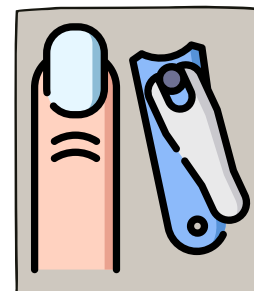
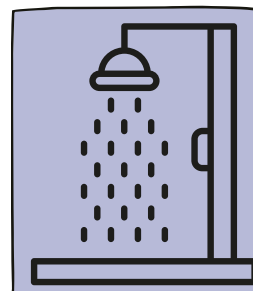
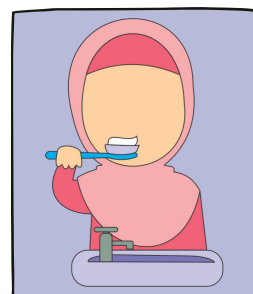


Keeping Clean in Islam: Why It's Important

By practicing Taharah, we're showing our love for Allah and the Prophet by staying pure in our hearts and in our actions. This means being kind to others, being neat, and taking care of ourselves.

How to Stay Clean

1. Wash Hands Often
2. Brush Your Teeth Twice a Day
3. Take Regular Baths or Showers
4. Trim Your Nails
5. Wear Clean Clothes
6. Comb or Brush Your Hair



How to Keep Your Environment Clean

1. Make Your Bed Every Morning
2. Tidy Up Your Room
3. Put Trash in the Bin
4. Keep Your School Bag Neat
5. Help with Cleaning Up After Meals
6. Keep Your Shoes and Toys Clean
7. Water and Care for Plants
