If anyone's last words are 'la ilaha illa Allah'
(There is no god but Allah), he will enter paradise."

The Meaning of the Hadith

Islam is the only religion accepted by Allah and He will reject all the other religions on the Day of Judgment. 'La ilaha illa Allah' is the gate of Islam. No one can be a Muslim without saying the shahadah (testimony of faith) with his tongue and believes in it with the heart. 'La ilaha illa Allah' means there is no god but Allah.

In this hadith Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him, teaches us, whoever says his last words in this life as "La ilaha illa Allah" he will enter the Paradise when he goes to Allah on the Day of Reckoning because his last words were the most truthful words.

People on the day of Judgment will be of two groups, one group will go to Paradise and the other will go to the Fire. No one will be allowed into the Jannah without Shahadah or kalimatu Al-Tawheed.
