The Prophet said, "Islam is based on five things: the testimony that there is no god but Allah and that Muhammad is His servant and messenger, the performance of the prayer, the payment of zakat, the fast during Ramadan and Pilgrimage." [Bukhari and Muslim.]

What does Zakah mean?

Zakah means blessings, growth and purification. Zakah is named so because it increases the wealth, blessings and faith of the individual who pays it.

Who must pay Zakah?

Not every Muslim is obligated to pay Zakah. Only those who meet the following conditions must pay Zakah: A Muslim who saves money, the value of this money worth 85 grams of gold or more, and this money is extra than the basic needs.



Who deserves Zakah?

Zakah can not be given to just anyone; there are certain kinds of people who deserve Zakah and it must be given only to them.

These kinds are:

- 1. The poor.
- 2. The needy.
- 3. Those who work the collection and distribution of Zakah,
- 4. New converts to Islam to strengthen their love for the faith.
- 5. Freeing slaves.
- 6. Paying off someone's debt.
- 7. For the sake of Allah.
- 8. For the travelers who ran out of money.



The obligatory charity shall be only for the poor and the needy, and for those who work to collect it, and to influence hearts (to belief), for ransoming captives, and debtors in the Way of Allah and the destitute traveler. It is an obligation from Allah. Allah is Knowing, Wise.

How to calculate your Zakah?

Lets learn how to determine how much money a Muslim must pay in Zakah. First make sure the amount of money you have is extra than your necessary needs, you saved it for one year and it is enough for you to walk to the jeweler and buy 85 grams of gold. If your answer is yes, then you have to pay Zakah and the question now is how much to pay.

You have to pay 2.5% of the amount of money you have. Lets give an example of Ahmad who saved \$10,000.

\$10,000 x2.5/100= \$250

Another easy way is to get the quarter of the 10th.

\$10,000

the 10th of the 10,000/10 = 1000

now divided 1000/4= \$250




