FAJR

Fajr Prayer is the prayer we do at dawn. It consists of 2 Rak'ahs

DHUHR

Dhuhr Prayer is the prayer we do at midday. It consists of 4
Rak'ahs

'ASR

'Asr Prayer is the prayer we do After noon. It consists of 4 Rak'ahs

MAGHRIB

Maghrib Prayer is the prayer we do at sunset. It consists of 3 Rak'ahs

ISHA

'Isha Prayer is the prayer we do at night. It consists of 4 Rak'ahs

In Islam, prayer (Salah) is one of the most important things a Muslim does every day. It is the second pillar of Islam, and it helps us stay close to Allah. When we pray, we talk to Allah, thank Him for all He has given us, and ask Him for help.

Praying five times a day reminds us of our love for Allah and how much we need Him. It also teaches us discipline and brings peace to our hearts.

Why is Prayer So Important?

- 1. Prayer connects us with Allah: Imagine having a direct phone call with the One who created everything. That's what Salah is like!
- 2. It makes our hearts clean: Just like we wash our hands to remove dirt, prayer helps remove bad things from our hearts, like anger or jealousy.
- 3. It teaches discipline: Praying five times a day helps us stay organized and responsible.
- 4. It brings blessings: Every time we pray, we earn rewards from Allah, and it brings peace into our lives.


