Ammar ibn Yasir was a loyal and brave friend of the Prophet Muhammad 2018. He was born in Makkah before the famous Year of the Elephant. Ammar's family was poor but strong and close. His mother, Sumayyah bint Khayyat, was a slave owned by a man from the Quraysh tribe. His father, Yasir, came from Yemen and settled in Makkah, hoping to find safety and a peaceful life. Ammar grew up in Makkah with his brother, Abdullah, in a city where most people worshipped idols instead of Allah.

When the Prophet Muhammad started calling people to Islam, he taught them to believe in one God, Allah, and to leave behind their idols. They put heavy, hot iron armor on their bodies and placed burning stones on them, pressing down so that the family would feel extreme pain. The Quraysh even burned their hands and feet with fire, hoping this would make them stop believing in Allah.

The Prophet Muhammad s felt very sad about what Ammar's family was going through. He wanted to help but couldn't, as the Muslims were few and didn't have the power to stop the Quraysh. The Prophet would visit them and give them words of comfort, reminding them that their reward would be in Paradise. He would say, "Be patient, O family of Yasir, for your destination is Paradise." This promise from the Prophet helped Ammar's family stay strong, even when the pain was hard to bear.


However, something terrible happened. Abu Jahl, one of the fiercest enemies of Islam, became very angry with Ammar's mother, Sumayyah. She refused to leave Islam, so he killed her with a spear. Sumayyah became the first person to die for believing in Allah, and she is remembered as the first martyr in Islam. Ammar's father, Yasir, was very old and weak. He, too, died from the pain and suffering caused by the Quraysh.

Ammar lost both of his parents but remained strong in his faith. He continued to believe in Allah, following the teachings of the Prophet ﷺ, even though he was sad and hurt.

Years later, the Prophet allowed his followers to leave Makkah and move to Medina. In Medina, Muslims could worship Allah freely. Ammar joined this journey, leaving behind the city where he had lost his family, but he carried with him their strength and memory. In Medina, Ammar became known for his strong faith, kindness, and courage, and the other companions admired him greatly for his bravery and loyalty to Islam.
