

IN YATHRIB

Before the Prophet reached Madinah he stopped by Qubaa, at the entrance of Madinah where he established the Masjid of Qubaa, then he entered Madinah. The people of Yathrib loved the Prophet and they couldn't wait for his arrival so they went outside Medina to welcome him. When the Prophet got near to Madinah, men, women and children went out to receive him and to celebrate his arrival. The Medina used to be called Yathrib but the Prophet changed it to Medina.

The Prophet stayed at the house of a man from Ansar called Abu Ayyub Al-Ansari. The first thing the Prophet did when he reached Madinah was let his camel walk until it reached a piece of land used to dry dates and had some palm trees. The Prophet asked about this piece of land and who owned it because he wanted to build his Masjid there. It was owned by two orphans, and they wanted to donate it, the Prophet refused to accept it as donation and he paid them. Then he started building his Masjid there.



The Muslims coming from Makkah were strangers in Madinah. They didn't have families, relatives or friends there. They left their families, houses and money in Makkah to be Madinah. able to move to The Prophet wanted to strengthen the Muslims, bonds between Muhajirun and Ansar. That is why he started a brotherhood between the Muhajirun Muslims (the migrated from Makkah) and the Ansar (the Muslims who lived in Yathrib). The Prophet made everyone from the people of Madinah (Ansar) to be a brother to a Muslim from Makkah (Muhajirun).
