The Meaning of the Hadith

Surah Al-Ikhlās is one of the greatest surah's in the Qurān. It teaches us about Allah and His descriptions.

The reason this Surah was sent down to the Prophet ﷺ is because the people of Makkah asked Prophet Muhammad ﷺ about Allah and His family and what He looks like. So Allah sent down this surah to tell everyone who He is.

In this Hadith Prophet Muhammad ﷺ is telling all Muslims how to make a lot of rewards in an easy way, keep repeating Surah Al-Ikhlās. Reading surah Al-Ikhlās one time will give you the reward as if you read one third of the entire Qurān.

One of the Sahabah of the Prophet ﷺ used to read surah Al-Ikhlās in his prayers all the time, the Prophet ﷺ asked him, "why do you keep reading this surah all the time?" The sahabi said: "because it talks about Allah and I love it." The Prophet ﷺ said: "Allah loves you because you love surah Al Ikhlas."

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Say: He is Allah, the only One قُلْ هُوَ اللَّهُ أَحَدٌ

Allah—the Sustainer اللَّهُ الصَّمَدُ

He has never had children, لَمْ يَلِدْ وَلَمْ يُولَدْ
nor was He born.

And there is no one equal وَلَمْ يَكُنْ لَهُ كُفُوًا أَحَدٌ
to Him
