

**Subject:** Reward and sins

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "When a person embraces Islam sincerely, then Allah Will forgive all his past sins, and after that starts the settlement of accounts, the reward of his good deeds will be ten times to seven hundred times for each good deed and one evil deed will be recorded as it is unless Allah forgives it." [Al-Bukhari and Muslim].

## The Meaning of the Hadith

This hadith explains what happens when someone accepts Islam and worship Allah alone. All his/her sins that were committed in the past will be forgiven by Allah, because Allah is generous and Islam erases the sins of the past.

The Prophet (ﷺ) continues to explain what happens after Islam, if a Muslim does or says something good, he/she will be granted 10 rewards for every good deed. The number of the reward may vary from 10 up to 700 rewards per good deed. This is because Allah is generous and Merciful and He loves Muslims and wants to give them more rewards so that they come on the day of Judgement with a lot of rewards and be saved from the Fire.

On the other side, if a Muslim does a sin, he/she will get only one sin for it not more, however, Allah may forgive this sin and erase it. This is because Allah is merciful to the Muslims and He wants them to come on the Day of Judgment with less sins.

**GOOD** = 10 × 700

**BAD!** = 1
